Informing the public in accordance with section 11 of the Hazardous Incident Ordinance



Dear Neighbours,

Our oil terminal is subject to the German Störfallverordnung (Hazardous Incident Ordinance) and is an operating area in the highest class. We are subject to the supervision of the relevant authorities and, in cooperation with them, have developed a hazard prevention plan and other emergency measures to prevent incidents caused by product leakage and to minimise the effects as far as possible. These findings were submitted to the authority as a safety report. Further information in this regard as well as the results of the last on-site inspection by the responsible authority can be obtained from the Gewerbeaufsicht Bremen (Occupational Health and Safety Inspectorate) upon request, taking into account the protection of public or private interests.

The last inspection took place on 21.11.2024

Ambrian Energy GmbH is a service company for the handling and storage of flammable mineral oil products and fuels. These include heating oils, diesel fuels and gasoline fuels, as well as the necessary additives and methanol. The materials are delivered and shipped by ship, rail tank wagons or tanker trucks.

Substances that may enter the neighbourhood in the event of an incident are:

Substances

Liquids, e.g. diesel fuels, heating oil, gasoline fuels, methanol, ethanol, additives and their vapours, combustion gases with toxic components and soot deposit

Characteristics

Extremely flammable, toxic, hazardous to health, hazardous to the environment, harmful to health

The trained operating personnel can intervene immediately in the event of substance releases and incipient fires and limit the possible effects until the arrival of the external emergency services (fire brigade, police). The fire alarm system is directly connected to the fire brigade operations centre.

In the event of a disruption to operations, the competent authorities shall be informed immediately. The neighbourhood will be alerted via loudspeaker announcements, over the radio or individually.

In the event of an incident, please close doors and windows and go into a building. Please stay away from the location of the incident. The possible malfunction may affect the air, soil or water.
